Tour A Historic Gold Mine!

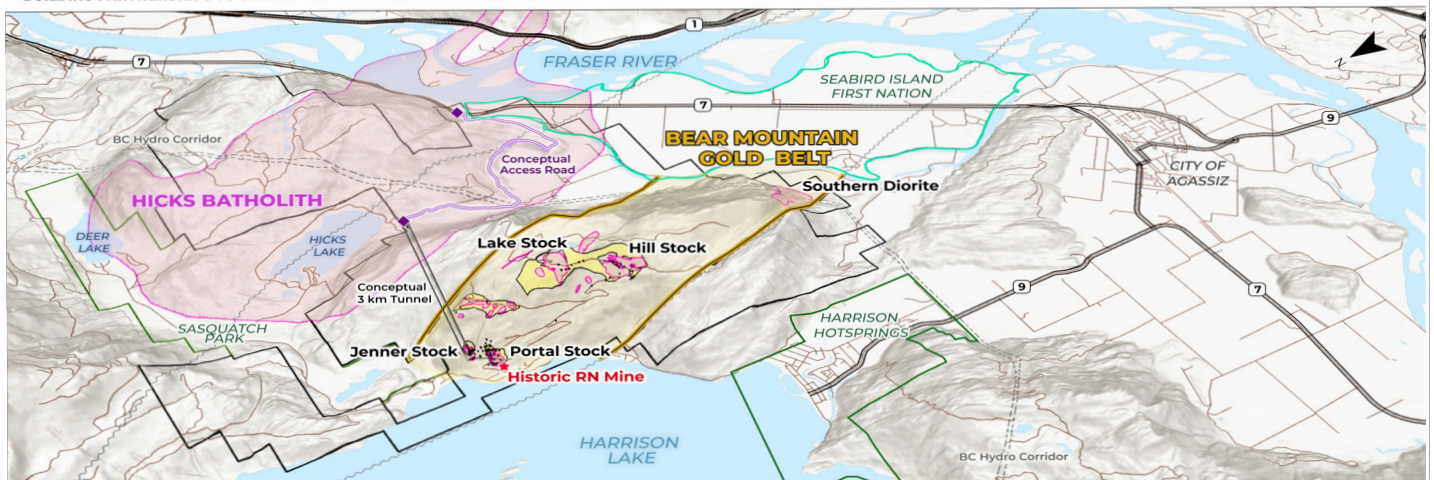
Join **MineralsEd** and experts **Derek Turner, Ph.D., P.Geo.** (Douglas College Chair, Earth and Environmental Sciences) and **Carl von Einsiedel** (CEO, Bear Mountain Mines) for a captivating underground tour of the Bear Mountain Gold Mine! Located a few kilometers northeast of Harrison Hot Springs, Bear Mountain Gold Mine was originally operated as a small high grade mine known as RN by local prospectors. The RN Mine was intermittently mined from 1972 until 1982. Historic smelter reports indicate that 30,443 grams of gold (978.89 ounces), and 616 kilograms of copper was shipped from the RN zone. Today, the mine is undergoing re-exploration to assess its potential.

This visit will include an overview of the history of gold prospecting and the importance of the gold rush to BC's economic development. Educators will get the opportunity to explore a safety-certified underground gold mine and and closely examine core samples used in exploratory work.
